The new Dickson Solar Fabrics collection: architecture and materials

The latest trend in architecture is to pair materials with new construction techniques to address the challenges of climate change and the environment, while satisfying the desires and expectations of consumers.



With its materials - some warm like wood or raw and worked like brick - and the clean, natural lines of stone, contemporary architecture provides Dickson's teams of designers with a choice palette of colors and inspiring graphic shapes.

The result is a collection enriched by 58 products divided into two esthetics.

TEXTURED SOLIDS

- **LINK: whimsical solids**
with a geometric texture recalling the delicacy of precious stones.
- **Piqués, tweeds and chinés,**
in bright, sophisticated designs with delicate textures and deep colors alongside more luminous and subtle colors to create a harmonious palette.

CONTEMPORARY STRIPES

Rejuvenated, fresh, harmonious or minimalist, traditional, restyled or asymmetrical - stripes structure fabrics and add a touch of modernity and depth to vibrant, invigorating fabrics in tune with the times.

Warpers

These operators prepare the warp yarns in accordance with the design, their length and density. The proper functioning of fabric production depends on their detailed and painstaking work.

Weavers

Weavers are fabric creators. They are responsible for the weave structure and colours of direct warping and produce fabrics by weaving yarn on looms.



Finishers

These operators are tasked with cleaning fabrics and applying a coating to guarantee the unbeatable performance and resistance of our fabrics.



Inspectors

Uncompromising and meticulous, they are responsible for inspecting the end quality of fabrics, spotting the slightest snag to guarantee an impeccable finish.

A fabric that protects from glare, heat and UV rays

Dickson fabrics **block up to 95% of glare and heat**. They reduce the greenhouse effect under awnings and keep interiors cool. What's more, depending on the colour, they **block 90% to 100% of UV rays**.

A hard-wearing and long-lasting fabric

The **solution-dyed acrylic yarn** used to make Dickson fabrics offers lasting resistance to external aggression, including rain and UV rays. Even when exposed to full daylight, **colours retain their intensity and brightness year after year**. A coating guarantees the fabric is **fully water-repellent**. Water is unable to penetrate the fabric, helping prevent all types of mold.

10-year warranty

Thanks to our fibres, weaving processes and high-performance coatings, Dickson fabrics come with a ten-year warranty. **Recognized for their durability, solidity and stability, they are systematically subjected to laboratory inspection to guarantee their impeccable quality.**

By choosing a Dickson fabric and following Dickson's maintenance guidelines, you choose sustainable consumption.

Our fabrics very often last longer than ten years. By regularly following our maintenance guidelines, our fabrics will naturally last even longer, **helping to protect the planet**.

Helping protect the planet

Awning fabrics are a highly effective solution to control light and temperatures indoors. They enhance the **comfort and energy efficiency of our homes**. This simple non-polluting technical solution naturally reduces the need for air-conditioning. Effective and long-lasting, Dickson fabrics come with a 10-year warranty and help reduce temperatures inside homes to limit the use of air-conditioning.



- Fitted over picture windows, Dickson awnings block the sun's rays and help **lower temperatures inside the home by up to 7°C**
- They allow natural light through while reducing glare
- They enhance privacy and protect from prying eyes

Dickson, committed to eco-responsibility

At Dickson, we take the environment extremely seriously. Dickson is firmly committed to a global eco-responsible policy, supported by its Greenovation program, which takes into account the entire lifecycle of its fabrics. From sourcing raw materials to managing the end of the service life of its products, Dickson is committed to producing environmentally friendly and long-lasting fabrics.

Eco-designed fabrics

From the drawing board onwards, our fabrics are designed to be long-lasting and kind to the planet. We make technical decisions that allow us to create highly resistant fabrics with **a long service life that optimize everyday comfort**. ORCHESTRA fabrics are certified compliant with Oeko-Tex Standard 100 (Product Class 2). This certification system for harmful substances in textiles confirms they are harmless to the environment and human health.

Selected raw materials

The main raw material used in Dickson fabrics is solution-dyed acrylic, in which the colour penetrates to the heart of the fibre, making it highly resistant to outdoor weather conditions. This choice allows Dickson to dispense with the fabric-dyeing stage, resulting in a less polluting industrial process that **considerably reduces the amount of water, energy and chemical products used**.

Production sites committed to a continuous improvement approach

Dickson's production sites are committed to a continuous improvement approach compliant with ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45001 and ISO 50001 for water, energy, the environment and more generally all issues related to quality, safety, the environment and energy. Dickson is the first French textile company to be awarded quadruple QSEE certification. The company was also accorded the CAP 26000 label in 2022 in recognition of its commitment to corporate social responsibility.

Target zero landfill waste

98,9 % of waste produced by Dickson's plants is recycled or recovered.

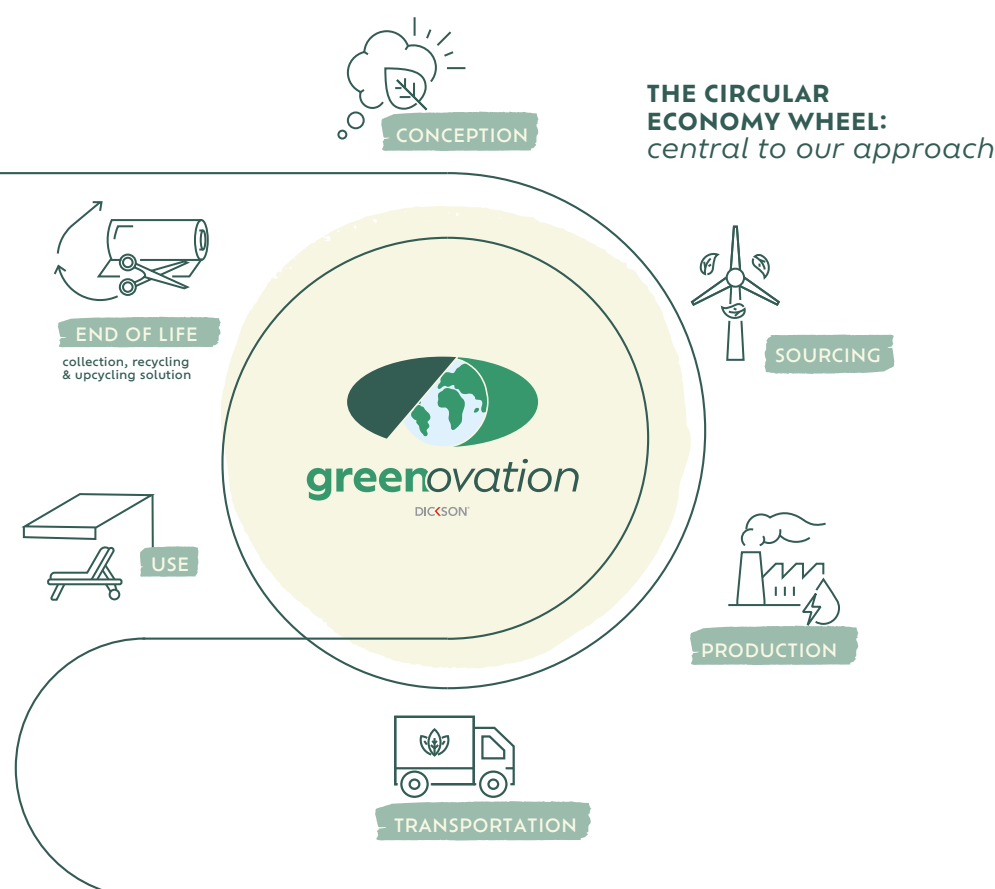


Optimized transportation

Dickson sources most of its **raw materials from Europe** and manufactures its fabrics in northern France. This helps to safeguard expertise and jobs in Europe. Thanks to its storage depots in Sweden, Italy, Germany and Spain, Dickson also offers a **local service** for minimal impact on logistic flows.

End of life? A second lease of life!

Dickson is also committed to the circular economy and takes part in recycling and upcycling programs to give fabrics a new lease of life by transforming them into tote bags, clutch bags, and more. The creative potential to **recover, reuse and recycle fabrics** is infinite.
